It is a great opportunity to pick up uniform clothing at a bargain price and help the school by donating 25% or 100% of your proceeds from the clothes you drop off at the sale. All clothes involved in the sale need to be school-approved clothing. Clothes can be dropped off during the hours of the sale. The clothing should not have any rips, tears or stains. If the clothing you drop off is tagged with your family name and a price, 25% of the proceeds from the sale of the item will go to the school and 75% will be returned to you. If you chose not to tag the clothing (no family name), 100% of the proceeds will go to the school. A list of all clothes sold is kept for each family in order to determine your proceeds. All clothes remaining after the sale will be included in the next exchange. Middle school students may earn service hours by helping to setup or tear down the sale.
