

HOT LUNCH – QUICK Q & A

1. How do I order lunch for my child/ren?
Each month, you will receive a notice that the lunch menu for the following month is available on our website. You and your child(ren) will decide which days/meal option he/she will choose, and will complete one order form per child. You will print your order(s), write a check for the total, and send all to school by the 5th of the previous month.
2. What do those choices mean?
Regular = everything that is listed.
Hungry = a larger portion of the entre that is listed
Combo = salad, soup, sandwich – you pick 2 (that day). Salad includes fresh greens & all the fixings, there is usually chicken noodle soup plus one other kind, and sandwiches are either salami, turkey, or ham.
Milk = if your child is taking milk that day, please mark how many here
None = if your child is bringing a cold lunch, please mark it here
3. Is milk included in the hot lunch price?
NO – a separate fee will be charged to cover milk for each lunch – please indicate if your child will be taking milk each day on the monthly order form (and how many each day).
4. 5. Do I need to use a separate monthly menu for each of my children?
YES.
6. When are the menu's and payment due?
On the 5th of the month PRIOR to the month for which you are ordering. If the 5th lands on a weekend, we will push the due date to Monday.
7. What if I don't get my menu & payment in by the 5th?
You'll be packing cold lunch for that month.
8. What if my child is sick?
Due to the focus on fresh ingredients, any food that has been purchased but not used will be donated to a local shelter.
9. May adults or younger siblings order?
YES! The price is the same for lunch, but you must add on \$.25 to the milk. Because we are receiving a federal subsidy for the milk, only students enrolled in our school may receive milk at the reduced rate. Adults and/or younger siblings also have to submit a menu with payment by the 5th of the prior month.
10. Will parent volunteers be needed?
YES! Our vendors provide a supervisor, but we still need those helpful hands to serve the students, wash the trays, & clean up; plus supervise the lunchroom and the playground.
11. What about peanut allergies?
Our vendor never uses peanuts or peanut products.
12. What about Lent?
No problem! You'll notice that all Fridays are meatless!
