Last year we celebrated the close of our 50th Year of Catholic Education at St Anthony on the Lake with another **fun and successful** Hot Summer Slice Dinner, Auction and Golf Outing event - the net proceeds from the event was approximately **\$70,000!** THANK YOU to everyone that supported this event, it was a great effort and all families, faculty, and staff should be very proud of what we accomplished together.

Proceeds from this event were used to complete the upgrade of the computers used in the computer lab and classrooms, purchase and install a smart board in the 2nd grade class, support the installation of new smart boards donated by parents for the 5th and 6th grade classes, and to support other needed projects and expenses associated with school operations.



In 2011 we are looking to increase the success and impact of this event benefiting the educational mission of St Anthony on the Lake Catholic Grade School. I know that with the support of our school families, faculty, staff, and the local community we can achieve great things and we are looking forward to another great year.

Through consultation with the School Committee, we have established our goals and objectives for this year's event, which includes a Stretch Budget Goal of **\$85,000**. Funds from this year's event will be used to complete the process of adding smart board technology to the classrooms by adding smart boards in the Kindergarten and 1st Grade classrooms and to invest in adopting the Interactive Science Curriculum being piloted this year for grades 6 through 8. Additionally, we plan to invest in teacher training; school supplies, facilities and technology maintenance and upgrades, and other general need items.
